Minecraft Bedrock Add-Ons

Bedrock supports a newer lightweight modding system called “add-ons.”

Add-ons can change:

- mobs
- items
- textures
- behaviour packs
- worlds

They are safer and easier to install than Java mods, making them great for kids and families.

Minecraft Realms: Private Worlds for Bedrock Players

Realms is Minecraft's official hosted world service, ideal for USA families wanting safe multiplayer.

Features

- always online
- invitations only
- no server setup
- cross-platform support
- parental controls through Microsoft accounts

Pricing

Typically a small monthly subscription.

Servers on Minecraft Bedrock (USA Popular Choices)

Featured servers appear automatically in Bedrock:

- Windows 10/11

- RTX-enabled resource packs

- realistic shadows
 - global illumination
 - reflections
 - physically-based materials
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Performance Tips for Minecraft Bedrock

These settings help stabilize FPS on consoles, mobile devices, and low-end PCs.

1. Lower Render Distance

Ideal range:

- Mobile: 6–10 chunks
- Consoles: 10–20 chunks
- PC: 12–24 chunks

2. Turn Off Fancy Graphics

This boosts performance dramatically on mobile.

3. Use Performance Mode Shaders

Bedrock doesn't officially support Java-style shaders, but some Marketplace packs optimize lighting.

4. Close Background Apps

Especially on mobile and Switch.
