Minecraft Bedrock Mods Complete Setup Guide

This guide walks you through the full process of installing Minecraft Bedrock mods across all major platforms. Follow each section carefully to ensure a smooth installation experience.

1. Installing Mods on Windows

- Download .mcaddon or .mcpack files from trusted sources.
- Double-click the file to import directly into Minecraft Bedrock.
- Open Minecraft and enable the resource and behavior packs.
- Restart the game if packs do not appear.

2. Installing Mods on Android

- Download the mod file to your device.
- Use a file manager to open .mcaddon files.
- Minecraft will launch automatically and import the pack.
- Enable the pack in world settings.

3. Installing Mods on iOS

- Download the .mcaddon file using Safari.
- Open it with Minecraft (if iOS allows the file type).
- Import the pack and enable it in game settings.
- Note: iOS has more restrictions; not all mods work.

4. Installing Mods on Xbox, PlayStation, and Switch

- Consoles have limited mod support outside the official Marketplace.
- External mods cannot be imported due to system restrictions.
- You can still use Marketplace addons and texture packs.

5. Loading Modded Worlds

- Create a new world with your selected packs enabled.
- Ensure behavior packs load before resource packs.
- If a world crashes, disable conflicting packs and reload.

6. Troubleshooting Common Issues

- "Unable to import pack": File is corrupted or incompatible.
- Missing textures: Ensure both resource and behavior packs are active.
- Game crashes: Remove heavy shader packs on low-end devices.

Always download mods from trusted websites and back up your worlds before installing anything new.
